

Through my works I explore emotive and perceptual qualities of time and memory and their occurrences in the organic world and in the virtual space.

My work is rooted in exploring philosophical concepts like Henri Bergson's concept of time and New Materialism, Eco-feminism, by the idea of the objet trouvé and concepts around the copy. I work cyclic, this means projects often blur into each other - through doubling, rearranging or distorting the material of choice and the subject of interest. My nomadic life and making are rooted in research and are currently happening between Germany, Portugal, UK and Japan. By manipulating organic and inorganic materials, I am seeking an alliance between biographical traces, the natural world, and the technoscene.











Nathalie Mei - In between we swim, Cycle 1 2022






